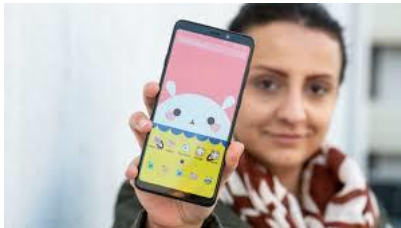

This cake is **MINE**

MINE = the cake belongs (pertenece) to me



This cellphone is **HERS**

HERS= It belongs to her

These words are called POSSESSIVE PRONOUNS.

There is one for each person. (Estos se llaman pronombres posesivos y hay uno para cada persona) **It is used to express possession.**

The Possessive Pronoun stands alone. It replaces the object (possession). Look at the example: e.g. These are my books. These are mine	I	Mine
	You	Yours
	He	His
	She	Hers
	It	Its
	We	Ours
	They	Theirs

Look at these examples carefully:

ENGLISH GRAMMAR **Possessive Pronouns** Woodward ENGLISH

A Possessive Pronoun replaces a *possessive adjective + noun* to avoid repeating information that is already clear.

- This book is **my book**, not **your book**. (Sounds repetitive)

- This book is **mine**, not **yours**. (Sounds more natural)

POSSESSIVE ADJECTIVE	POSSESSIVE PRONOUN
MY My shirt is green.	MINE The shirt is mine .
YOUR Your book is new.	YOURS The book is yours .
HIS His pillow is soft.	HIS The pillow is his .
HER Her dog is small.	HERS The dog is hers .
ITS Its bone is old.	---- * * We don't use its as a possessive pronoun.
OUR Our bird is noisy.	OURS The bird is ours .
YOUR Your house is big.	YOURS The house is yours .
THEIR Their car is slow.	THEIRS The car is theirs .
